



## Provider Review and Feedback

Care Partners of Connecticut develops clinical policies based on sound evidence to evaluate the medical appropriateness of health care services. All content is objective and comprised of current scientific evidence and care guidelines. Policies are developed with consideration of individual needs and characteristics (e.g., age, comorbidities, prior treatment and complications) and the availability of services within the local delivery system. The policy review process includes review from experts, participating providers and feedback from consumer groups, medical associations, professional associations and interested parties.
